Todd Berry To Address Marathon County Towns & Villages Associations

MADISON—Wisconsin state budget issues and how they affect local governments will highlight the address by Todd A. Berry, when he speaks to the Eastern and Western Marathon County Towns and Villages Associations on July 24 at 7:30 p.m. at the Rib River Ballroom in rural Marathon. Berry is president of the Wisconsin Taxpayers Alliance (WISTAX).

Berry will cover state aid, transportation, local control, and other issues as they relate to the state's current fiscal condition.

A public-finance expert with graduate degrees from Harvard University, the University of Chicago, and UW-Madison, Berry's knowledge of state-local finance is sought by civic and business organizations throughout the state.

Since 1994, he has headed the Taxpayers Alliance, an independent, nonpartisan organization dedicated to public-policy research and citizen education.

Prior to joining WISTAX, Berry, a UW-Madison grad, spent more than a decade as marketing director for a Wisconsin food company. He also served the state of Wisconsin as Assistant Secretary of Revenue and as Executive Director of the Governor's Tax Reform Commission from 1978 to 1983. Berry's past public service includes the Dane County Board, the Jefferson School Board, and the North Central College (Naperville, Illinois) Board of Trustees.
