IN BRIEF

For the first time in four years, party control of the two houses of the Wisconsin legislature is split, with Democrats controlling the 2007 senate and Republicans in charge of the assembly. The office of governor remains in the Democrats' hands. Key details include:

- Democrats gained four senate seats and now have an 18-to-15 majority, their first since 2002.
- In the lower house, Democrats gained eight seats, but Republicans kept control (52 to 47).
- Governor James E. Doyle won reelection, becoming the first Democrat to accomplish that feat since former-Governor Patrick J. Lucey in 1974.
- There are four fewer women in the legislature as several female incumbents chose not to run and others lost their races.
- The average age in the 2007 assembly is 51, up from 50 during the 2005 session; the average senator is 54, up from 52.

The New Wisconsin Legislature

After four years of Republican control of both houses of the Wisconsin legislature, voters returned Democrats to power in the senate (18-15) and reduced the Republican majority in the assembly (52-47). The assembly gains were the first for Democrats since 1991, while the shift in the senate has become a regular phenomenon.

Legislative Business. One of the first places the impact of the November 2006 results will be felt is in the state budget process. The legislature's attention will be almost entirely focused on the 2007-09 spending plan to be unveiled by the governor in February.

Much of the budget work from then until the legislature debates it in June or July will occur in the legislature's Joint Committee on Finance (JCF). Formerly dominated by the GOP (12-4), split legislative control means that JCF will have eight members from each party. This parity, along with split chamber control, will mean that the state budget process will likely be more tempered, guided by compromise. However, should either party stake out inflexible priorities, the result could be a return to the budget impasses of the late 1990's.

Along with the changes in the legislature came changes in the leadership of the two houses. The new assembly and senate leaders, elected by their respective party legislators, are listed in the table below.

Legislative Makeup. Despite the pick-up of seats in both houses by the Democrats, the lawmakers elected to serve during the new two-year session are largely those who served during 2005-2006. Of the 132 legislators taking the oath of office on January 3, 2007, 112 served during the prior session. Included in that figure is one new senator who moved up from the assembly (John Lehman).

In the lower house, there will be 17 new faces, nine Republicans and eight Democrats. The senate will have four new members, all Democrats.

The 2007 Wisconsin legislature has 102 male and 30 female members. Forty years ago, there were only two female legislators, both assembly Republicans. That figure has risen over the years with strong gains made from 1999 to 2003, when the number of women in the assembly rose from 19 to 27. The number dropped to 26 in 2005. With several female incumbents not running and others losing, the 2007 assembly has 22 women. The upper house will continue to have eight female senators, the same as in the last two sessions. The number of women in the senate is down from a high of 11 in 1999 and 2001.

The new legislature is slightly older than in past years. In the assembly, the average age is 51, up from 50 during the 2005 session. The average for state senators is 54, up from 52 in 2005. □

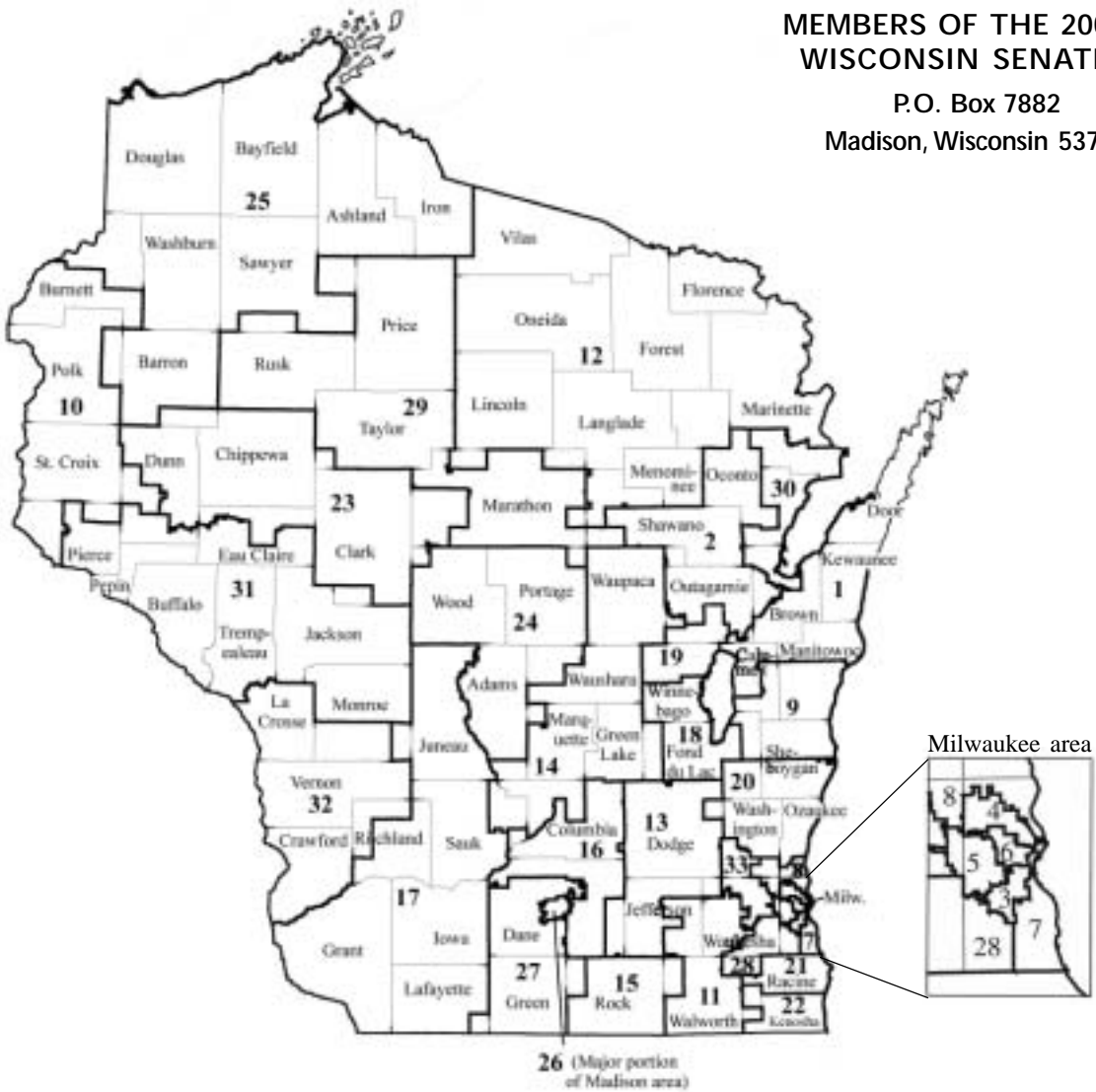
State legislative control will be split with Democrats controlling the senate and Republicans in charge of the assembly.

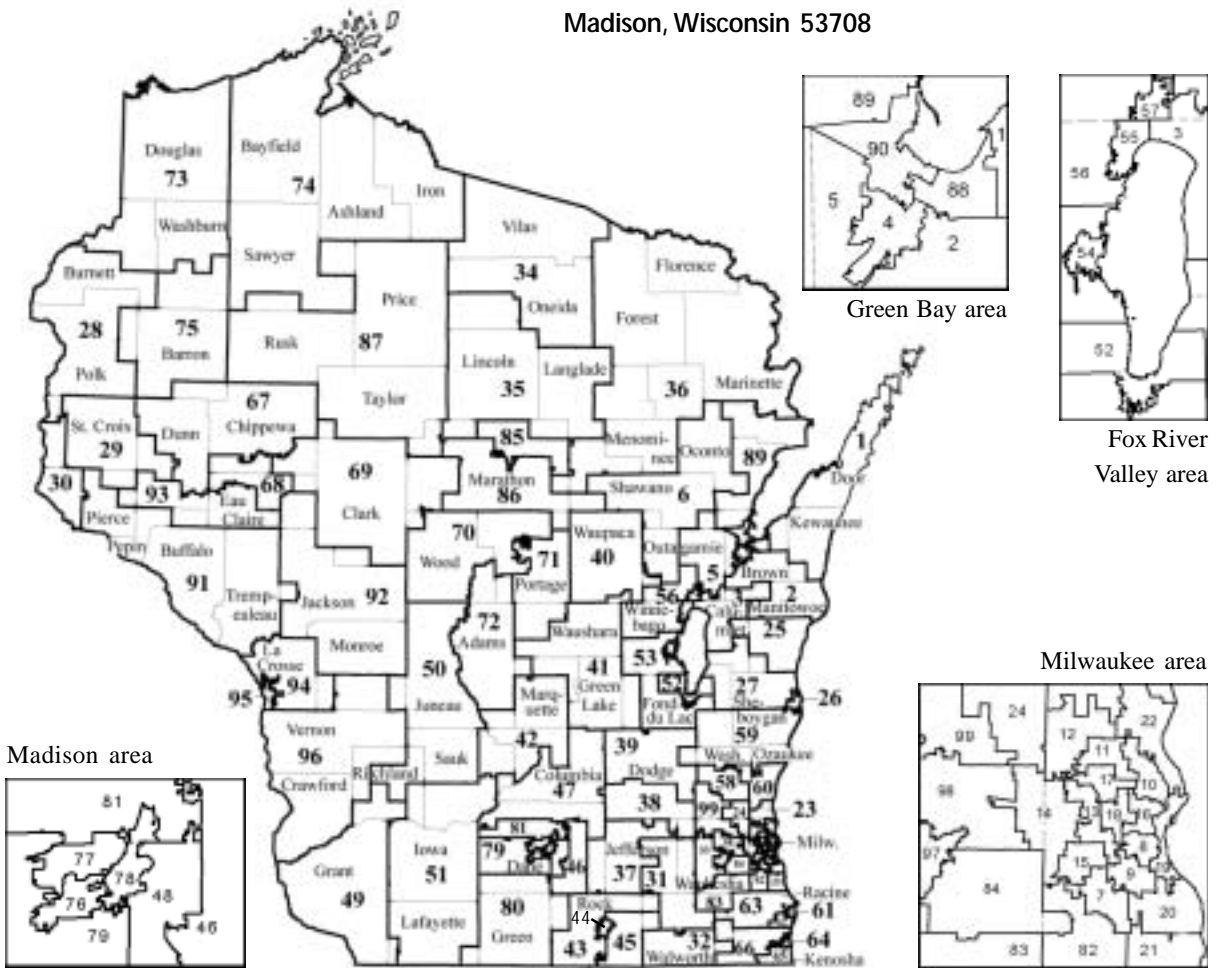

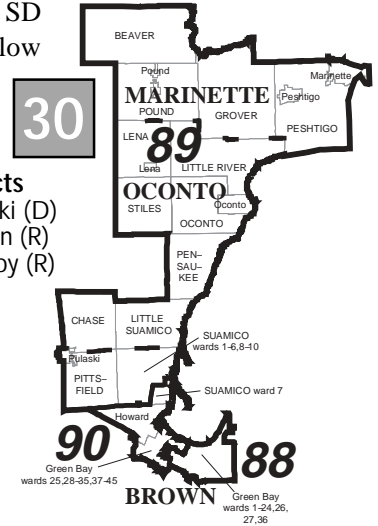
